

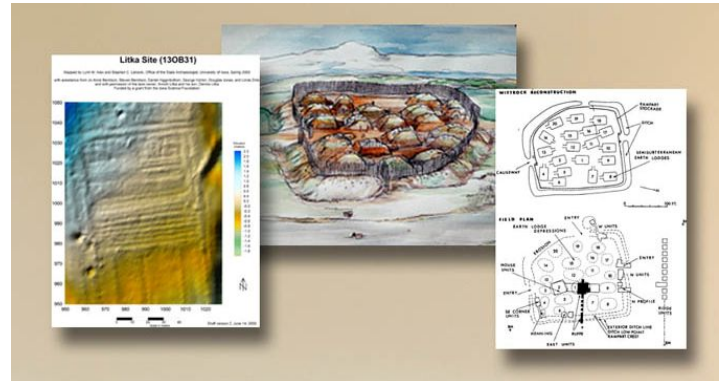
Opportunities await at the
