For Youth!

Effective May 10, 2008, a person shall not operate a vessel in Iowa unless every person on board the vessel who is age 12 and under is wearing a U.S.Coast Guard approved life jacket. The life jacket must be worn whenever the vessel is not at anchor, tied to a dock or the bank/shore or is aground.

Hunting Dog Restrictions

Remember that dogs are prohibited from running on state owned ground until after July 15 of each year.



You need to have a valid hunting license and have paid the Habitat Fee to train a bird dog on game birds. Iowa Migratory Bird Fee and a Federal Waterfowl Stamp is required if using waterfowl taken from the wild, and a valid Fur Harvester License and a habitat fee is required to train a coon hound, fox hound or trailing dog on any furbearing animal at any time of year.
